As we go past Candlemas, and turn 'from the crib to the cross,' there are several things to look out for that you might like to take part in during Lent, aside from the usual 'special services' on Ash Wednesday and during Holy Week:

- There will be a weekly **Lent Group**, looking at material from/recommended by +Mark.
- Nearer Passiontide, there will be opportunity to engage with **Prayer Stations** around the church, to explore the themes of Lent, and the journey to the cross, more deeply.
- On Palm Sunday evening, there will be a service of **Music & Readings for Passiontide** think 'Advent Service of Light', but for Lent!

Wellbeing Cafe

The possibility of St Martin's holding wellbeing cafes is being explored at the 'moment - 'coffee morning' type occasions (though not necessarily in the morning!), to reach out into the community, encourage fellowship, and provide a safe space for people to simply be themselves.
